A JOINT EDUCATIONAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ROCKFORD CAREER COLLEGE AND JUDSON UNIVERSITY

This agreement is made by and between Rockford Career College and Judson University.

Whereas, it is the desire of the Parties to expand educational services to the greatest number of students in the Community College District,

Whereas, the Parties believe that implementation of this agreement holds promise for the further development of higher education in the Community College District,

Therefore, Judson University agrees to provide upper-level courses and baccalaureate degree programs in articulation with Rockford Career College associate degrees and courses.

- 1. Students in good standing will be allowed to transfer all of their completed coursework, to a maximum of 66 credit hours for those entering a traditional program and 88 hours for those entering an Adult Professional Studies Program into a specified Bachelor of Arts degree programs at Judson University.
- 2. It is understood that this agreement will take effect immediately and will stand until modification is deemed necessary by either party. Such modification shall be officially noted in writing.
